Purchase Procedures and Requirements

Group rates are available when you purchase 20 or more tickets with the same start date.

- Groups must be centrally coordinated and organized, and have a group leader who serves as the group's on-site coordinator.
- Pre-Purchased orders and payment must be received at least two weeks prior to ticket start date.
- Must have a single form of payment for entire order: cash, check, or credit card must be presented before tickets can be printed. Commission is only available to those travel agents holding an IATA/ASTA/ARC number. Make checks payable to Vail Resorts, Inc.
- All tickets must be paid for in advance.
- All youth and college groups are required to participate in a complimentary safety session prior to skiing and riding unless the entire group is participating in ski school.
- On-site Add-on Ticket Policy: The designated group leader or the travel agent coordinator
 must make all add-on purchases. No individual members of a group may purchase add-on
 tickets. Changes to the ticket order will not be allowed within 72 hours prior to start date.
 Payments must be made at the time of pick up. Additional lift ticket requests must be
 submitted in writing by email or fax.
- On Site Ticket Extensions: Tickets may be extended on site by the individual ticket holder.
 The extension rate will be the prorated daily rate of the full ticket. Ticket holder must pay for the ticket at time of purchase and turn in the used ticket.
- When a multi-day ticket is purchased that will cross a seasonal price change, the price for the entire ticket will be based on the rate of the start date.
- Complimentary Ticket Policy:
 - One comp ticket will be issued for every 25 people in your group. Once you reach 25 people your sales representative will calculate how many comp tickets you are eligible for. Ticket types do not have to be the same to count toward comps; for groups with mixed ticket types, one comp skier day will be awarded for every 25 paid skier days. Comp tickets have no cash value.
- Refund Policy: No more than 10% of the total ticket order may be refunded for groups. Refund
 requests must be made no later than 30 days after the group departs for any unused tickets.
 Partially used tickets are non-refundable, except in the case of documented injury or illness,
 the group leader must handle all refunds. If a group lift ticket order falls below 20 tickets due
 to refunds, the full ticket window rates will apply to the original order; comps issued will also
 be assessed at window rate. Unused tickets must be presented at time of refund.
